# Travel Tips & Reminders



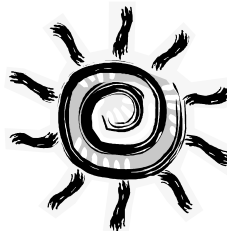
## Traveling by Car

Please have your child arrive at camp between 9:00 am and 12 noon. You will find directions at the bottom of this sheet. Upon arrival to camp, please follow the signs to the athletic field. (NO CARS DRIVING THROUGH CAMP.) From here your child's luggage will be unloaded and taken to his/her cabin. Please **check in under the tent** and if you haven't already done so, deposit money into your camper's account for the camp store. Your child's counselors will greet you once you arrive, and they can show you around camp. We encourage you to visit the health hut and meet the nurses, as well as go see your child's cabin. We request that you keep your opening day visit short to help campers adjust and get into camp life.

**Closing day pick up is between 9:00 am to 12 noon.** Again, we ask that you proceed to the athletic field and your child will meet you with his/her counselor. The luggage will be waiting at the field, and someone can help you load it into your vehicle. If you have other plans for your luggage, please let Beth know at the check-out table. If you find that your child is missing an item, please notify the counselor. Every attempt will be made to locate an item and mail it to you. Please proceed to the tent to settle your account. Please inform us in writing if your child will be departing with someone other than their parent.

## Traveling by Bus

Camp Highlander provides round trip bus and luggage transportation between camp, Boca Raton and Jacksonville, Florida. We also provide a bus between Baton Rouge, Meridian, Birmingham and Atlanta when there is adequate demand. A round trip ticket on the bus is **\$280 per camper** and the luggage service is **\$125 per camper** making the **total cost for both services \$405**. (Atlanta \$305) Payment for the bus and luggage service is due in full upon receipt of the signed Bus Form. No spots will be held without payment in full. One way fares are not available. ## Traveling by Plane

When you are making your plane reservations, remember that all flights **should arrive and depart from the (AVL) Asheville, NC airport before Noon**. It is just 8 miles from camp, and we are happy to escort you to camp, at no extra charge, if you will be traveling with your child. Transportation to and from the airport is included in your camper's fees.

**ALL airlines require that a child be at least 15 years old to fly alone.** Therefore, you will be responsible for paying any unaccompanied minor fee (\$100) for each way of travel. **CAMP HIGHLANDER WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY TRAVEL FEES.** Dave Smith is in charge of airport travel and will be at the airport to receive your child from the airline attendant, wearing a Camp Highlander staff shirt. All flights must arrive or depart by Noon from the Asheville Airport.

Please attach the enclosed luggage tags to your child's luggage. We recommend that you send your child's luggage UPS one week prior to their arrival date, to ensure that it is here when he/she arrives. The airlines have STRICT baggage restrictions, so please call the airlines in advance if you choose to send luggage by plane.

Please **DO NOT** call the camp office on opening day to check on your child. We will contact all parents of campers, who arrived by plane, to let you know that your child has arrived safely. Please be patient, as we have a lot of parents to contact.

## Directions to Camp Highlander

**FROM I-26:** Exit the WNC Agricultural Center/ Asheville Airport exit #40. Go West on Highway 280 towards Brevard. You will pass the Asheville Airport on your right hand side.

Travel approximately 4 miles and look for Valley-Agri Feed & Seed. At this stoplight, turn right onto South Mills River Road.

Continue on South Mills River Road for 3 ½ miles and you will see a Camp Highlander sign on your left after the Mills River Baptist Church.

Turn left at the next road, which is Dalton Road. Continue on Dalton road for ½ mile, which will take you directly into camp.

Follow the signs once you are on camp.
